PRESS RELEASE

Last date of withdrawal of candidature was 5<sup>th</sup> November, 2016 and the time is over by 3 PM. Now two candidates, namely Smti Dasanglu Pul – BJP and Smti Yompi Kri – IND are in fray. The Bye-election will be a straight contest between BJP and IND. All necessary arrangements were made by the District Administration for smooth conduct of poll. Election Commission of India has deployed two Election Observers, one is Suparna Das Ahamad, General Observer, Mobile No.09436435021/09830141712 and another is Vinayak Azad, Expenditure Observer, Mobile No.09436435031/09811302391. Both the observers accommodated in Ampani Lodge (Govt.Circuit House), Khupa, at Hayuliang. Model Code of Conduct enforced strictly in entire district. Since the district is located in international border necessary steps have been taken to deploy sufficient security forces. In all earlier occasions the poll was conducted peacefully in Anjaw district. There is a polling station (52 – Malogam) having only two electors in the district. Chief Electoral Officer, Arunachal Pradesh appealed the voters of Anjaw District to maintain same spirit which was done in earlier occasions and cooperate with the election machinery for smooth conduct of poll.


