PRESS RELEASE

Election Commission of India has notified Bye-Election to 45-Hayuliang (ST) A/C vide No.EC/PN/58/2016 dated 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2016. Notification in this regard has been issued today, the 26<sup>th</sup> October, 2016, as scheduled. Last date of Nomination is 2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2016. Date of Scrutiny of the Nomination is 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 2016 and last date of withdrawal of candidature is 5<sup>th</sup> November, 2016. The election will be conducted on 19<sup>th</sup> November, 2016 and counting will take place on 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2016. Total electorate in the district is 11003 (Male – 5495 and Female – 5508). 100% EPIC coverage has been achieved. Total number of polling stations are 81 of which 3 polling stations viz. 1-Kibitho, 64-Aphumna and 65-Taflagam are situated near the international border with China. Highest number of electors (955) are in 41-Hayuliang Polling Station and lowest number of electors (02) are in 52-Malogam Polling Station.

The CEO had called a meeting of DC/DEO Anjaw and SP Anjaw to review poll preparedness in Nirvachan Bhawan on 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2016 in which Nodal Officer from PHQ, Representatives of DC Lohit, DC Namsai and representative of BSNL were also present. Another meeting of political parties was held on 25<sup>th</sup> October, 2016 in Nirvachan Bhawan and sought cooperation for smooth conduct of poll. Directions were given to DC/DEO Anjaw to set up few polling stations with women polling personnels only. One model polling station will also be set up amongst the international border polling stations. Necessary logistic support on polling personnel, micro observers, sector magistrates and vehicles etc. will be given by the Lohit and Namsai District Administrations. Adequate security personnel will be deployed for smooth conduct of election. Directions were also given to implement model code of conduct strictly and take stringent action towards the government employees who are involving in political activities. BSNL authorities were also directed to provide reliable communication facilities considering the geographical condition of the district.
