No. 464/EPS/2024 (1).—WHEREAS, the President of India has, by Notification issued under sub-section (2) of Section 14 of the Representation of People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951) and published in the Gazette of India on the 20th March, 2024 (Wednesday), been pleased to call upon each of the parliamentary constituencies, specified in column (2) of the Schedule below, in the States or Union Territories mentioned in column (1), of the Schedule to elect members to the House of the People, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the rules and orders made thereunder;

- 2. **Now, therefore,** in pursuance of Sections 30 and 56 of the said Act, the Election Commission of India hereby-
 - (A) **Appoints,** with respect to the said election, from each of the parliamentary constituencies specified in the said Schedule,
 - (a) the 27th March, 2024 (Wednesday), as the last date for making nominations;
 - (b) the 28th March, 2024 (Thursday), for scrutiny of nominations;
 - (c) the 30th March, 2024 (Saturday), as the last date for withdrawal of candidatures;
 - (d) the date specified in column (3) of the **SCHEDUL**E below, as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken in the parliamentary constituencies, specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) of the said Schedule; and
 - (e) the 6th June, 2024 (Thursday), as the date before which the election shall be completed in all the above mentioned parliamentary constituencies; and
 - (B) Fixes the hours specified in column (4) of the said Schedule, as the hours during which the poll shall, if necessary, be taken in the constituencies, specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) of the said Schedule, on the date specified against such constituency in column (3) thereof, for the above election.
